Trust Tree

Description: This station will help someone to identify places of anxiety and worry. With scripture reflection and meditation the individual will entrust places of anxiety to the Father and receive the blessing of truth found in the Word.

Supplies you will need:

- To make leaves
 - Colored craft paper
 - Wire (4-5" sections cut)
 - Scissors
 - Clear tape
 - Assortment of branches
- Decor
 - Vases or cinder blocks to hold branches up
- Prayer engagement
 - Sharpies
 - o Scripture passages available to read

Instructions:

These are for many of us, anxious times. Anxiety and worry are easily bottled up within us. This station is designed to help you off load your worries and concerns onto the Lord, the one who carries us and is always with us. Blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, for he will be like a tree Planted by a stream, and will not fear when the heat comes, and will not be anxious in a year of drought, nor cease to yield fruit. (Jeremiah 17:7-8)

- 1. Find a comfortable place to sit.
- 2. Recognise where you may be holding tension in your body.
- 3. Invite the Lord to any place where you are holding anxiety or worry. "Come, Lord."
- 4. Read through the scriptures. Linger with the Lord.
 - a. Ask yourself, am I leading a quiet life?
 - b. Ask for wisdom and wait
 - c. Pause an extra minute and ask the Lord to speak
 - d. Ask for guidance to quiet any unsettled place within you
- 5. Find one or two scriptures that connect with you.
- 6. Choose a leaf. Write your prayer on it.

- 7. Tape a wire to it.
- 8. Secure it to the branch.
- 9. Pause. Wait in stillness.
- 10. Listen and receive the blessing.
- 11. Thank the Lord for meeting you.

Scriptures to Have Available

Jeremiah 17:7-8
